Saturday, May 15, 2010

Laguna Seca Golf Ranch. All Flights 8:30 A.M. Shotgun Start. Participants must be in their carts by 8:15 A.M.

Sunday, May 16, 2010

Eagle Ridge Golf Club. All Flights 8:30 A.M. Shotgun start. Participants must be in their carts by 8:15 A. M.

NCNGA AWARDS BANQUET- Awards Banquet will immediately follow Sunday's final round play at Eagle Ridge Golf Club

1. Format- The tournament shall be 36 holes at stroke play, 18 holes daily on May 15th on Laguna Seca Golf Ranch and May 16th on Eagle Ridge Golf Club. Men's flights will play from the white tees; Super Senior Flight will play from the Forward or Yellow tees; ladies will play from the red tees. Play will be at 100% of the course handicaps calculated from May 1st, 2010 indexes
2. Field Competition Awards-All players shall be eligible for the Field Low Gross or Field Low Net Awards. Those qualifying will be eligible for the Senior (55yrs) Low Net Award, Super Senior (65yrs) Low Net Award or the Super Senior (75yrs) Low Net Award.
3. Ties for Field Awards- In the event of a tie or ties for 1st place only, in all Field Awards the USGA tie –breaking procedures will be used. Refer to Appendix 1, part C, 11 "How to Decide Ties" (c) if ties still exist after the procedure on the last nine of the final round, the same format will continue on the first nine until any ties are broken.

4. Ties for Flight Awards- In the event of a tie or ties for any Flight Awards, the ties will be broken by the net score of the final round; the USGA tie-breaking procedure will be used on the final round. If a tie still exists, then the same procedure for the first round will be applied.
5. Awards- No Player is eligible for more than one award except for the Team, Senior, Super Senior and the Super Super Senior Flight Awards.
6. Senior Flight- Any player turning age 55 prior to the 15th of May 2010 will be eligible for the Senior Flight (Minimum 12 Players).
7. Super Senior Flight- Any player turning age 65 prior to the 15th of May 2010 will be eligible for the Super Senior Flight (Minimum 12 Players).
8. Super Super Senior Flight- Any player turning age 75 prior to the 15th of May 2010 will be eligible for the Super Super Senior Flight (minimum of 12 Players).
9. Team Competition- Teams may consist of 4 or 5 Participants from one club. Clubs may enter more than one team but no player can be on more than one team. The four lowest individual net scores for each designated team will be combined for each round. The Lowest 2-day net total score will be determined the winner. Ties will be broken by comparing first, the team total net scores of the final round; next, the total of the team's three lowest net scores; then the total of the team's two lowest net scores and lastly the one lowest net score. If a tie still exists, the same procedure for the first round shall be applied. Any changes to the team members must be in writing and submitted to the Tournament Committee prior to the first round Check-In.
10. Closest to the Hole- On all par-3 holes, each round a competition for Closest to the Hole will be conducted by Flights.
11. Optional Skins Game- Competition will be conducted by Flights, Using 80% of the course handicap.
